- The content supports the need to use both primary and secondary sources for assignments.

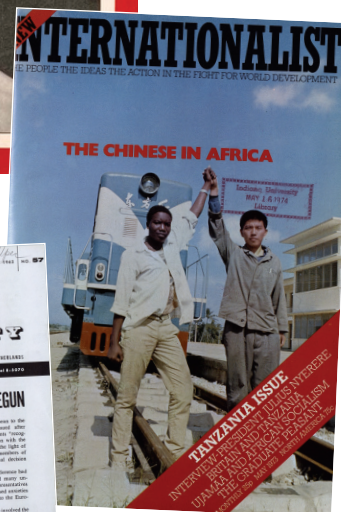
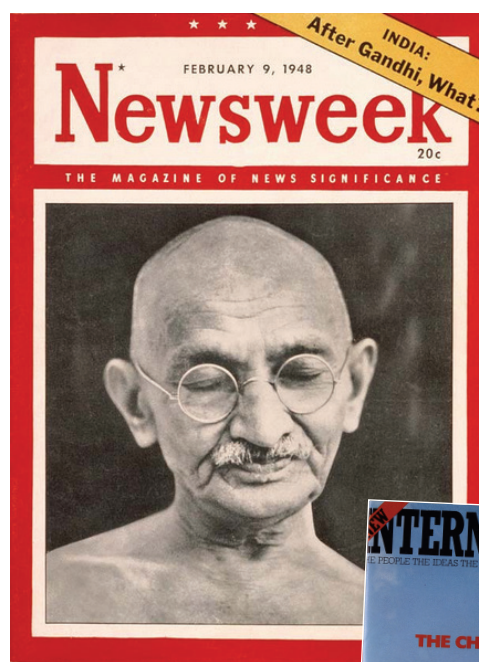
Rarities and responses

At the same time, the archive offers access to rare backfile content, dating back to 1918.

- Magazines include those no longer in publication, giving users valuable historical content.

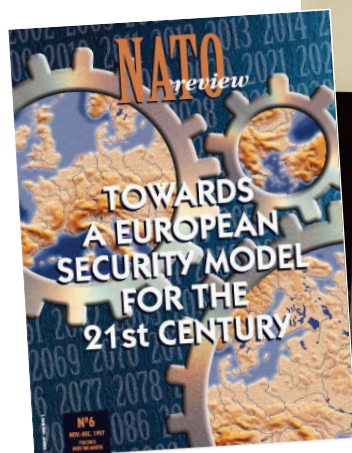

Premium content, diverse views

Anchored by *Newsweek*, this growing collection spans decades and continents to deliver cover-to-cover content tied to social and political topics – with articles voicing diverse political orientations and international perspectives.

In the collection's historic pages, researchers will find both contemporary comment on all of the major political events of the 20th and 21st centuries and contextual material for research areas like gender studies, ethnic studies and media history.



The first release of News, Policy & Politics Magazine Archive includes material from:

- *Americas* (1949-2015): Published for over 60 years, *Americas* focuses on political and cultural issues relating to member nations of the Organization of American States.
- *Church & State* (1948-2015): Vehicle of Americans United, devoted to advocating for the separation of church and state.
- *Dollars & Sense* (1974-2015): Focusing on minority economic development, it is renowned for publishing reporting outside of the mainstream media coverage.
- *NATO Review* (1953-2015): Addresses international defense and security issues, offering views from government agents, NATO officials, and global opinion leaders.
- *New Internationalist* (1971-2015): An esteemed British radical activist magazine devoted to international development and issues in global justice.
- *Newsweek* (1933-2012): Recognized for its scope of news and sometimes controversial commentary, the print version was among the most influential and high-circulating consumer titles of the 20th century.
- *World Tomorrow* (1918-1934): Predecessor publication of *Fellowship*, it advanced the voice of Christian socialism in the US.
